Guidelines for Submission:

*Abstract: 200-250 words in English, including rank, affiliation, email address and mailing address for all authors.

*Title: The title should be centered, uppercase for initials. Times New Roman 12pt font size, single-spaced should be used. Please, send the document in <u>Word</u> format as an <u>attachment</u> (not in the body of the email) and include no more than six keywords. *Submissions will be evaluated by a peer-review committee. The conference working language is English.





*Conference Fees: \$200.

- Fees can be paid upon arrival only for pre-agreed arrangements.
- For Palestinian and Jordanian participants: Conference fees are APETAU membership fees.
