A Jordanian national, whose family consists of his wife **Dr. SANA' ALI SHIQWARA** and his four children: **Dr. TAMARA, Dr. AHMAD, Dr. SARA and Dr. MOHAMMAD.**

While pursuing his undergraduate studies, he took on a series of small jobs to support himself. After graduating in 1977, worked as an accountant for a while before becoming a supervisor at a poultry and incubation farm. He also worked as a sales manager, a factory manager before becoming afterwards a member of the senior management at a shareholding Company.

He launched his own private business in 1984 with the establishment of "**YAN**" Company, the acronyms of which represent his own name, that of his father and his family name. He began with limited capital, dealing in foodstuffs, goods, industrial raw materials, land development, real estate, agriculture, pharmaceuticals and medical supplies.

He also invested in many public and private shareholding companies in the fields of education, health and industry, as both CEO and member of the board of directors. He was keen to shoulder his social responsibilities, thus he directed his companies to carry out projects and initiatives that emphasize their commitment to the development of the local community, and contribution to provide the favorable circumstances for human, economic, social, scientific and environmental development.

His commitment of higher education, scientific research and community service started in earnest in 2005 when he bought Middle East University (MEU) (a not-for-profit institution), launching its "**knowledge is Power**" motto.

He formulated its vision to be a "Serious, Committed and Seeking to learning" University, a concept which reflects his own philosophy in life.

He sought to improve higher education in the Arab level by launching and chairing an initiative to implement governance at Arab Universities.

He published a series of papers in international peer-reviewed journals in addition to articles published in several Jordanian daily newspapers such as "AL-RAI, ADDUSTOUR, AL-GHAD" in which he tackled many topics in which the Jordanian public opinion is interested. His publications reflect his belief in the importance of strategic thinking and wisdom as a source for understanding and analyzing public affairs in order to arrive at the best solutions to some the challenges facing us today. He also took part in many conferences, seminars, workshops and courses relevant to his areas of expertise and interests.

He is the recipient of many awards from various national and international organizations and institutions in recognition of his achievements .
