**Note:** The Jordanian General Secondary Education (GSE) certificate in vocational streams (industrial, hotel, home economics, and agricultural) is accepted for previous years without additional admission requirements provided that a document from the Ministry of Education is presented, proving that in the year the student fulfilled his/her GSE requirements, he/she was not required to study two additional subjects.

## Admission Requirements (Undergraduate Programme)

### General Secondary Education:

- General Secondary Education certificate (Tawjihi) or its equivalent.
- Adhere to the minimum average requirements as follows:

The minimum admission average for Jordanian students is (60%), except for the Law programme (65%) and all engineering and pharmacy programmes (80%). Students should have a minimum score of (50%) in all subjects.

- Non-Jordanian students may be admitted with a maximum of 15 marks below the allowed average for Jordanians, provided that they adhere to the GSE streams required for joining each programme and have a minimum average of (50%).
- Jordanian students holding other nationalities may not be exempted from meeting the average requirement for joining any of the University's programmes.
- International students holding a Jordanian nationality may not be exempted from meeting the average requirement for joining any of the University's programmes.

### Bridging:

- Students holding a Jordanian Community College Diploma (two and three years format) with a minimum average of (70%) and who have passed the Comprehensive Exam with a minimum average of (68%), except for pharmacy and engineering programmes (70%), are accepted in equivalent programmes as outlined by Al-Balqa' Applied University.
- Bridging for the Pharmacy programme is limited to holders of the GSE scientific stream certificate or its equivalent.
- For bridging purposes, special needs students whose names are listed by the Supreme Council for the Disabled and who have passed the Comprehensive Exam (two and three years format) with a minimum average of (65%) may be accepted through the Unified Admission Committee at the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in programmes equivalent to their university majors.
- Students holding a Jordanian Community College Diploma (three and four years format) who did not sit for the Comprehensive Exam may be admitted, provided that they sit for the Qualifying Exam held by Al Balqa' University and pass with a minimum score of (68%) for all programmes, except for pharmacy and engineering programmes (70%).
- Non-Jordanian students holding an associate degree from abroad may be admitted to equivalent programmes outlined in the lists issued for this purpose.
- The University transfers the credit hours the student has completed in his/her associate degree, whether studied in Jordan or abroad, provided that they do not exceed (50%) of the study programme credit hours (two and three years format), except for the Pharmacy programme where the percentage would be (25%) of the approved study plan.

### Transfer students:

- Transfer students may be admitted, provided that they pursue their studies on full-time basis. A maximum of (50%) of their study plan credit hours will be transferred into their study programme.

- General Secondary Education certificate's (Tawjihi) original transcript or a certified copy.
- Students with foreign certificates should obtain their equivalence from the Jordanian Ministry of Education.
- Photocopy of your passport for non-Jordanians, and the identity card for Jordanians.
- Photocopy of birth certificate.
- Military service booklet for male Jordanians or an exemption certificate.
- Two recent personal photographs.
- If existing, a certified copy of the Community College Diploma and a certified transcript from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research.
- Certified transcript from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and course description for transfer students.
- Certificate of non-issuance of disciplinary action for transfer students.

## The Higher Diploma in Education Programme

The Higher Diploma in Education was established at Middle East University in dedication to the University's vision, mission and objective to advance all stages of the educational process, and in an effort to uphold our social responsibility. We highly value teachers' role in shaping our future, thus we aim to prepare educational leaders who are bound to adequately serve their respective sectors, accelerate human development endeavours, and assume an active role in intellectual and professional advancement. The programme's set objectives are aligned with the requirements of local and international labour markets; and designed to fulfill the demand for highly-qualified teachers, principals, educational supervisors, teaching methods and curricula specialists, educational consultants, and other competencies needed in the field.

### Features of (Higher Diploma in Education Programme) :

- Applying students should have fulfilled their Bachelor's degree requirements on a full-time basis, regardless of their GPA.
- If a student's Bachelor's major was unrelated to the field of education, they will be required to study a maximum of 9 credit hours of remedial courses.
- Students who obtain their Higher Diploma with a minimum rating of «very good» are eligible, regardless of their Bachelor's rating. In this case, a maximum of 12 credit hours will be transferred into their chosen study programme.
- The Higher Diploma programme consists of 27 credits hours.

### Admission Requirements (Higher Diploma in Education Programme) :

- Applying students should have pursued their Bachelor's degree on a full-time basis at an accredited university.

### The postgraduate programme consists of:

- 1- Comprehensive Track:** in which students must pass (33) credit hours divided into (24) compulsory credit hours and (9) elective credit hours, and then sit for a comprehensive exam for all subjects.
- 2- Thesis Track:** in which students must pass (33) credit hours; (9) thesis credit hours, (15 - 18) compulsory credit hours, and (6 - 9) elective credit hours.

### Admission Requirements:

- Applying students are expected to have a minimum of 'good' rating or its equivalent in their undergraduate studies.
- Students should have been full-time students during their undergraduate studies at a recognised university.
- Sit for an English Skills Exam in accordance with the applied regulations of the Jordanian Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, as follows:

- In case of failing the English Language Skills test, a student will be required to study a remedial course of (6) credit hours in the first semester of enrollment. The student must pass the remedial course according to the minimum admission requirement, or his/her registration will be forfeited.
- Students who obtained their Bachelor's by affiliation and a Higher Diploma by a full-time study are exempted from the Qualifying Programme (30 hours), provided that the Higher Diploma's major matches the Bachelor's. If the Higher Diploma's accredited hours were less than (30) hours, the student will be required to complete (30) accredited hours as assigned by the chosen department.
- Accredited organisations for language tests are AMIDEAST and ETS in Jordan (for TOEFL), British Council in Jordan (for IELTS), and the National English Equivalency Test from language centers at Jordanian public universities.
- If applicants' Bachelor's majors were different from their Master's chosen majors, they may be recommended to study remedial courses (no more than (9) credit hours set by the Faculty's Dean) during their first year of study.
- Students with a rating of "fair" may be admitted under the above mentioned conditions, provided that they study three courses determined by the faculty, and successfully complete them in the first semester of enrollment with a minimum average of (70%) or its equivalent in each course and a minimum GPA of (75%) or its equivalent. Students who do not fulfill these conditions forfeit their registration.
- Students holding a High Diploma degree with a minimum rating of 'very good' may be accepted in the Master's programme regardless of their Bachelor's GPA.
- Students holding a Vocational or Technical Diploma (since they are not higher diplomas) are not allowed to apply for postgraduate programmes.

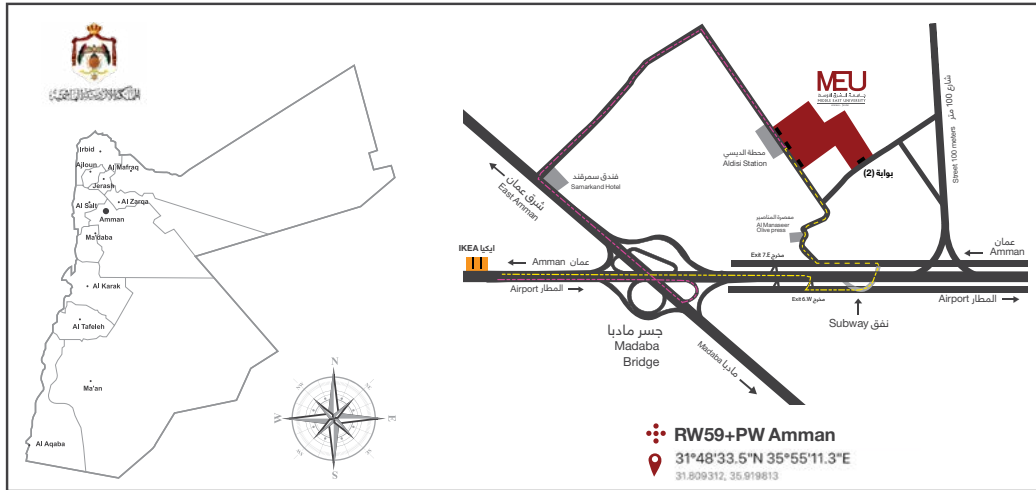

### About the Master of Pharmacy Programme (MPharm)

Pharmacists are experts in medicine who work alongside doctors, nurses and dentists as part of healthcare teams.

As a pharmacy graduate, you'll need to understand the science behind drug discovery, development and delivery along with how patients react to the medicines they take. You'll also have to understand individual patient care and public health issues to deliver the best health and pharmaceutical care. Our pharmacy degree combines science and pharmacy from the start. Our aim is to provide you with the skills and knowledge to be a medicines expert to choose from the full range of pharmacy careers.

The programme is jointly delivered by the Faculty of Pharmacy at MEU in Amman, Jordan and the Strathclyde Institute of Pharmacy and Biomedical Sciences in Glasgow, Scotland. Both institutions have strong links with the community, hospitals and sectors of the pharmaceutical industry. The MPharm degree is an integrated, full-time, five-year undergraduate programme.

Suitably qualified students will be admitted directly into year one of the programme, where they will spend their first three years at the Faculty of Pharmacy at MEU and continue years four and five at SIPBS in Glasgow, Scotland.

Students enrolled at the joint MPharm programme will undertake community and hospital placements with optional summer research projects both in Jordan and the UK.
